22 Chablis 'Gloire de Chablis' J. Moreau et Fils (Chablis)

23 Sancerre 'Château de Sancerre' Marnier-Lapostolle (Loire)

The Chateau is right in the heart of the quality land in Sancerre.

24 F.E. Trimbach Gewürztraminer (Alsace)

The house of Trimbach was founded in 1626 – this is a great example of their rich, rounded wines.

56 Chateau Musar Red Gaston Hochar (Bekaa Valley) £40.00

Made from Tempranillo, Mazuelo & Graciano – the classic grapes of Rioja.

- 73 Bourgogne Pinot Noir ‘Couvent des Jacobins’ (Burgundy, France)** **£15.50**
 Made from a selection of Côte d’Or and Côte Chalonnaise villages.
- 74 Château du Seuil, Graves (Bordeaux, France)** **£17.00**
 A fantastic blend of 50% Merlot and 50% Cabernet. International Wine Challenge: Commended.
